

Program Application Deadlines 2018-2019

Published April 1, 2018

All FACTOR deadlines are set for 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time on the day of the deadline listed below. Please see **Business Policies: Application Process** for more details.

NEW: If you have never applied to FACTOR before, you must first create and submit an Artist Profile and an Applicant Profile BEFORE you can create and submit your Artist Development or Juried Sound Recording Project Application. You may do this any time, including the same day you submit your ADP or JSR Application. To do so, complete only the Mandatory Information section of the Artist Profile.

Once you have created and submitted these profiles, they will automatically receive a provisional rating that allows you to go straight to the application process. You do not have to wait for the profiles to be reviewed by FACTOR before starting your Artist Development or Juried Sound Recording application.
